CPS On-Track Metric

Students need to have at least a 95% attendance rate and good grades in ALL subjects to be considered on track.

The higher their attendance, the better.

The higher the grades, the better.

Students who have poor attendance and poor grades are off-track for success and not on the path to graduation. Students that are off-track may be considered for interventions and may risk summer school.
